Subject: SPECIAL PROGRAMS

PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to properly account for meals/snacks provided to special programs.

PROCEDURE

Separate reports are required for the special feeding programs provided by the Department of Food and Nutrition, Miami-Dade County Public Schools. These programs can be divided into two categories:

Programs Requiring On-Site Collection

Special Activity Sales SPACT – 9912 Vending Machines (Commission Checks) VEND – 9914

Programs Billed by Food Service Accounting

- Reimbursable Meal/Snack Programs
- Non-Reimbursable Meal/Snack Programs (e.g. ASO, YMCA non-reimbursable, United Way Head Start, Head Start Adult Meals, etc.)
