## Subject: **RECYCLING IN FOOD SERVICE AREA**

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of these guidelines is to facilitate recycling within food service areas.

### **GUIDELINES**

### General Information

The Department of Food and Nutrition supports the District's initiative in recycling. To reduce waste collection and its associated fees, paper items and cardboard boxes are encouraged to be recycled in the food service area.

- A. Collect the following items and place in the recycling dumpster at the end of the day:
  - 1. Paper, newspaper, magazines
  - 2. Flattened cardboard
- B. Do **NOT** dispose of the following in the recycling dumpster:
  - 1. Styrofoam, trays, cups, plates
  - 2. Plastic bags
  - 3. Food waste
  - 4. Plastic wrapping/packaging
  - 5. Aluminum wrap
  - 6. Cans
  - 7. Glass bottles, jars
  - 8. Plastic bottles
