

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND NUTRITION NEW PRODUCT TESTING AND EVALUATION



Vendors interested in submitting food products for consideration by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Department of Food and Nutrition must do the following:

Step 1

Manufacturer, Broker and/or distributor must submit to Attn: Director of Food and Menu Management, the Department of Food and Nutrition, Food Planning and Production Test Kitchen, 7042 West Flagler Street, Miami, Florida 33144, the following information:

- 1. Ingredient label
- 2. Nutrition Facts Label
- 3. Portion size, unit and case size
- 4. A copy of the product data sheet and food label including the manufacturer's code number and establishment number of the manufacturer if a meat product
- 5. Child Nutrition (CN) label, if applicable
- 6. Meal pattern contribution to USDA National School Lunch or Breakfast Program
- 7. Pricing scale

Step 2:

If requested for the product to be reviewed:

- A full-case sample from a production line, not a specially made sample, is to be submitted to the Department of Food and Nutrition, Food Planning and Production Test Kitchen, 7042 West Flagler Street, Miami, Florida 33144
- 2. Sample must have a food label imprinted on packaging and the date/shift coding.
- 3. Sample is to be marked with (1) Vendor's name, (2) Bid number as applicable (3) Item number as applicable (4) Product brand name and number(s) (5) grade/portion and case size.
- 4. Product(s) will be screened based upon appearance in the raw and cooked state for acceptability of shape, texture, color, smell, plate coverage and availability of recommended preparation equipment.
- 5. Storage, handling and cooking directions.
- 6. Appointments for sample submissions may be made by contacting Ms. Susan Rothstein, Director at 786-275-0400.

Step 3

If requested by the Department of Food and Nutrition for Student Taste Test/Evaluation at designated school site(s):

- 1. Full sample case(s) from a production line will be delivered to designated testing sites. Samples are to be the same as the items submitted for the Appearance Screen.
- 2. Product(s) will be tested/evaluated at all test sites.
- 3. Food products will be rated by students as acceptable or unacceptable using a hedonic scale.

Samples: Samples must be provided at no cost to Miami-Dade County Public Schools. The Department of Food and Nutrition and/or Miami-Dade County Public Schools will assume no cost incident thereto.
