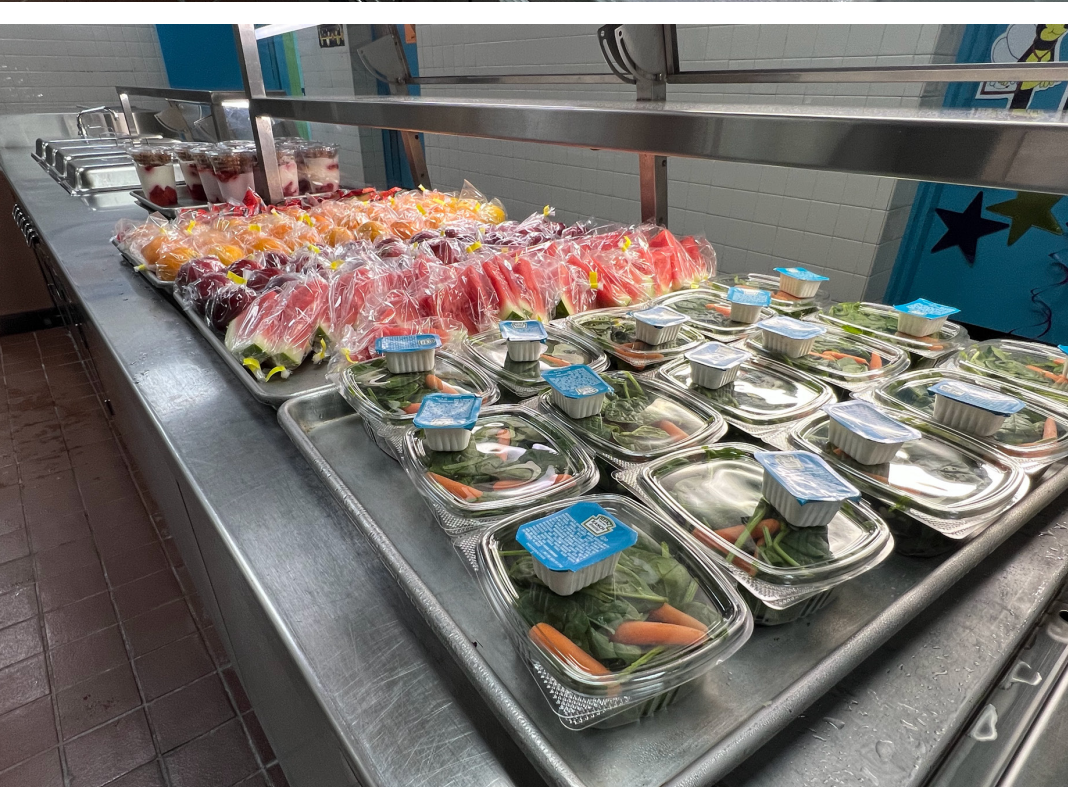




BETTY BABICH





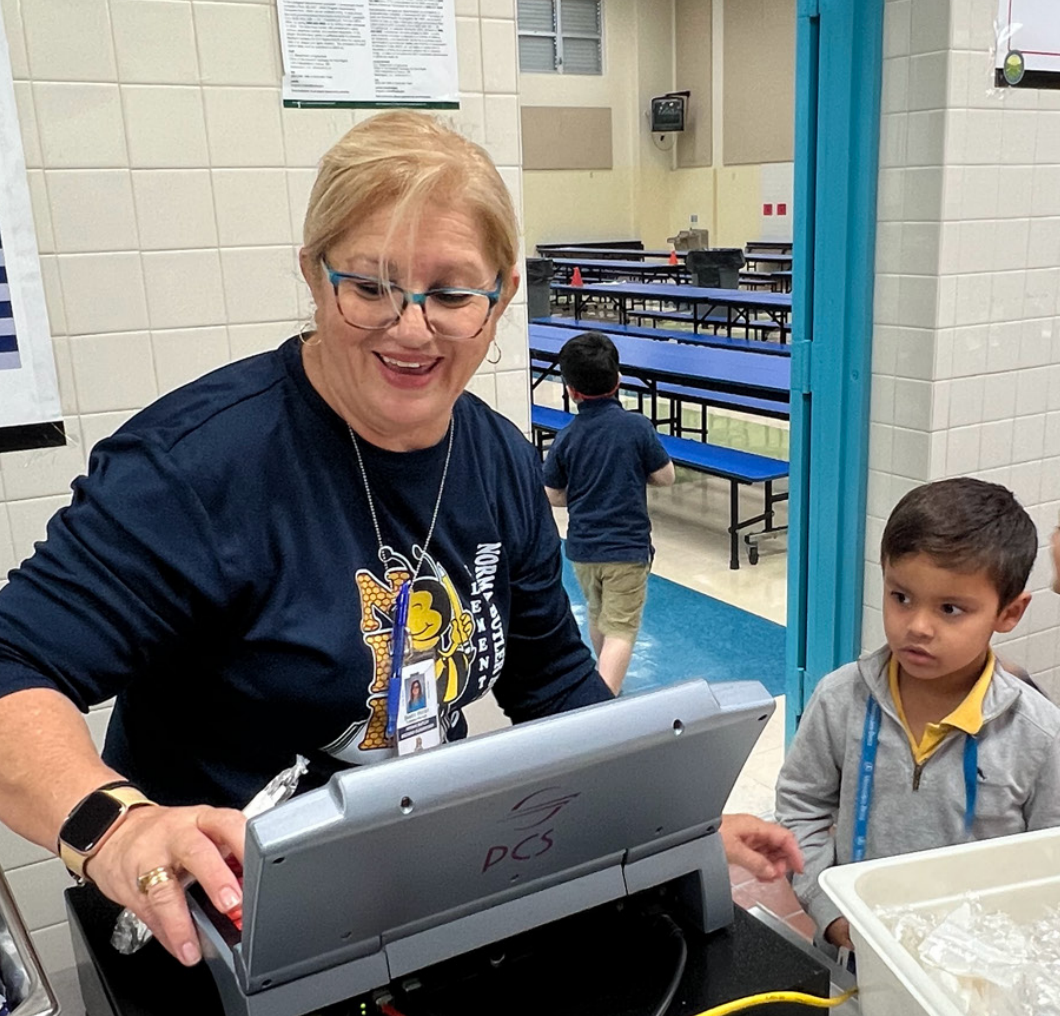
